

Advanced Placement Exhibition

March 15 – April 2, 2021 Virtual Gallery Exhibition Hosted by The Art League of Long Island

Dear Art Educator,

For the fourteenth year in a row the Art League of Long Island is pleased to offer the opportunity for High School Advanced Placement art students throughout Suffolk and Nassau counties to exhibit their work in an AP Art exhibition entitled, "GO APE". Each High School may submit up to 4 works to be apportioned as the teachers see fit among Drawing Portfolio, 2D Design Portfolio and 3D Design Portfolio. We hope to represent a wide cross section of media: Drawing, Painting, Printmaking, Mixed Media, Sculpture, Photography, and Computer Graphics. This exhibition will feature talented art students working across Long Island and will give the students the opportunity to view artwork created by their peers in a virtual gallery setting on the Kunstmatrix platform, a resource for professional artists and galleries.

In that AP students are aiming at careers in the fine arts, presentation appropriate to a professional virtual gallery setting should be stressed. The file size required by the virtual gallery program must be between 500KB - 5MB in a high-quality photographic image, with image width of about 1900px. File types accepted are PNG, JPG, or JPEG only. For 3D work, please be aware images will appear as enhanced 2D photos, and that the student must take two images of the work, one from the front and the other from the back, making sure to maintain the same distance and height from the object in both photos. Use of a cell phone is suitable to accomplish this task, however for best image quality please make sure images are sent via email attachment, not through text message. Please send your images no later than March 2.

Awards will be given to honor outstanding work created in each two and three-dimensional content area.

To ensure space for your students' work we are asking teachers to reserve space and submit one application for each work submitted. To apply please answer all questions on the reservation form at https://forms.gle/gfoGaFeThTTPoqUZ9.
