

## ELIGIBILITY

- This is a national exhibit, open to all artists residing in the United States of America.
- Entry is limited to 5 works not previously exhibited in another juried ALLI show, one of which may be selected by the juror for admission.
- Two- and three-dimensional work in any medium may be submitted, including photography and fine craft. Sorry, no videos.
- Deadline for application Sunday, June 14, 11:59pm.

## SPECIFICATIONS

- Two-dimensional work may not exceed 62" high by 50" wide INCLUDING FRAME.
- Three-dimensional work for display on pedestals may not exceed 15" wide by 15" deep by 30" high. ALLI will provide pedestals. Three-dimensional work designed to stand on the floor may not exceed 28" wide by 28" deep by 60" high.
- Accepted work must be delivered **BY EMAIL** to gallery@artleagueli.org no later than Tuesday, July 6th, 11:59pm. See "Delivery of Accepted Work" for details.
- Entries judged not suitable or inappropriate will be disqualified at the sole discretion of the Art League of Long Island.

## FEES

Members: First 2 images = \$35; \$5 each additional image up to 3. Total maximum 5 images. "Member Code," specific to this exhibit, is emailed to all current members.

Non-members: First 2 images = \$45; \$5 each additional image up to 3. Total maximum 5 images.

## SALES & PRIZES

- Three Awards of Excellence (\$100 each) and three Honorable Mentions (one year memberships in ALLI) will be given at the discretion of the judge.
- ALLI will retain a 30% commission on all exhibition sales.
- The price represented on the artist entry form will be the sale price. No changes will be allowed.

## SUBMISSION OF WORK

- Go to [www.artleagueli.org](http://www.artleagueli.org) and access the call for artists tab under the exhibitions menu. You may also go directly to <https://artleagueli.org/awakening/> Alternatively you may go directly to <https://client.smarterentry.com/alli>
- Once in SmarterEntry please click on the "Sign Up Now" link. If you have not used SmarterEntry before, follow the directions on the Site Login Page to create a new profile. Your username is your email address.
- Click on **Awakening** to register (it is under the heading AVAILABLE SHOWS). You will be taken to a secure site where you can pay your application fee. Members must enter the Member Code to get reduced application fee. Members will receive a code by email.
- Once you have paid your application fee, you can upload your images. Submit your images as JPG, TIF, or PNG files not greater than 4MB. The longest side should be 1,280 pixels or greater. Click on the Choose File button to browse for the file you want to upload from your computer.
- Upload your image as directed. Please note that all fields marked with an asterisk are required. Click Add Image to upload it to the show. When the image appears in the column on the right, it has been submitted successfully to the competition.
- Repeat this process for all your images. You can click "Return to Account" on the left hand bar at any time, then return later to submit more images. You can delete and resubmit a new image at no additional cost. Add optional artist's statement at this time. You can edit information submitted or upload additional images up to the deadline.
- Include one image of each two-dimensional work.
- Include up to three images of each three-dimensional work. Use "Add View" to make composite image (3D only).
- Acceptance: Notification of acceptance of work will be posted on our website the week of June 28th.

## DELIVERY OF ACCEPTED WORK

- **This exhibit will be available to view in an on-line virtual format**, accessible through a link on the Art League of LI website.
- Accepted work should be emailed to gallery@artleagueli.org
- It is recommended that accepted work be in a file-size between 500kb and 5mb - saved as compressed high quality jpg.
- The image width of large pieces of art should be about 1900px. Images must be smaller than 5000x5000 pixels.
- Files must be less than **5 MB**.
- Allowed file types: **png jpg jpeg**
- Please send two images for 3D works, one frontal view and the other from the back.

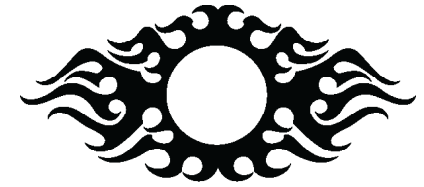
